These two individuals are San Jose City College students who are working as Project Engineer Interns with XL Construction Corporation. XL is the General Contractor that SJECCD hired to prepare the new District Office for occupancy. This is the best example of career pathways curriculum and education.

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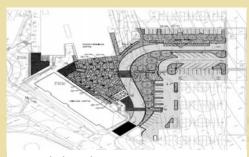

# **Scheduled Maintenance:** MEP Phase-2 (DSA/OCIP) (G-10)

san josé evergreer COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT

Project consisted of mechanical and electrical scopes of work for multiple buildings on campus:

- The electrical scope included: installation of upgraded lighting fixtures, installation of additional exit signs, and installation of new card readers.
- The mechanical scope included replacing actuators, replacing exhaust fans, louvers, thermostats, insulating valves and piping, re-anchoring dampers to frames, replacing drift eliminators, removal of heat pump units and condenser units, and installation of pressure booster system.
- The project reached substantial completion in December 2013.



# **Physical Security (G-10)**

This multi phased project will advance the Campus Physical Security Initiative through the identification and implementation of specific measures related to the improvement of safety and security throughout the campus.

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The measures developed will generally focus on the following areas:

1. The development of a Master Plan including security expectations, specified systems and interconnections

2. Evaluating levels of threat related to emergency response.

3. The enhancement of Video Surveillance, Emergency Communication and Access Control systems

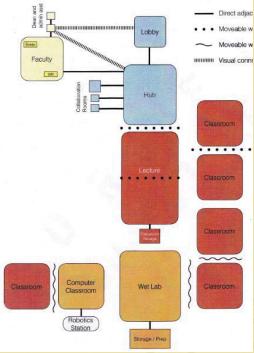

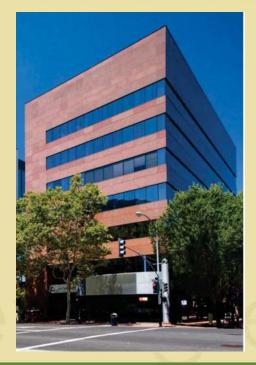

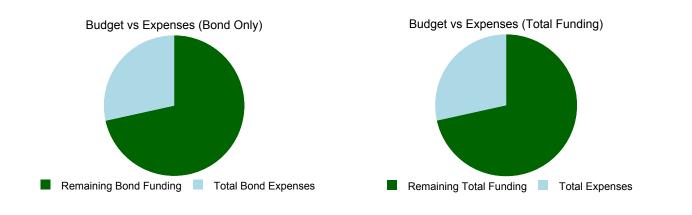

This process adheres to the accountability standards outlined by Proposition 39 and provides transparency in the evolution of the project list.

These revisions are the result of the application of a consistent process for the tracking and management of budget and expense related to the overall management of the Measure G-2010 Bond Program.

Projects 39905: Management and Related Costs and 39999: Election/Legal/EIR/ DO Labor and Related Costs are managed as separate projects in the Bond Program; however, the activities in these two projects benefit all active projects. By managing these activities as standalone projects during the year, the District's bond management team is able to view and manage the budget and expenses that impact all projects in one location. These costs are allowed to be distributed to projects for capitalization purposes. The bond management team has determined that spreading the 39905: Management and Related Costs and 39999: Election/Legal/EIR/ DO Labor and Related Costs budget and associated expense to the active projects annually, as is allowed, provides a transparent view of the program.

Measure G-2010 Bond List Revision #10 represents the transfer of budget, equal to the expense that will be spread to the individual projects through expense transfers prior to fiscal year close. In this way, the budget balance remaining in 39905: Management and Related Costs and 39999:Election/Legal/EIR/ DO Labor and Related Costs at the end of the fiscal year will reflect what remains for future years, and the projects will capture the expenses attributed to them.

Measure G-2010 Bond List Revision #10 includes the following actions:

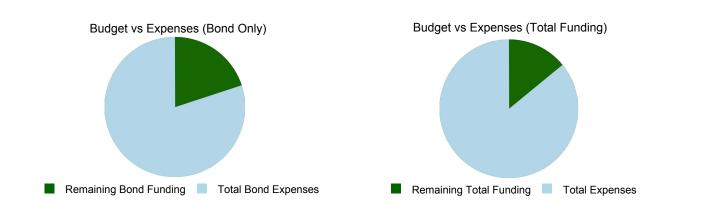
